## Having a public quality standard for medicines helps:

- Pharmaceutical companies produce quality medicines
- Regulators ensure quality medicines reach patients
- Uphold practitioner and patient confidence in healthcare











Introducing the USP Quality Institute

- Our commitment to building an evidence base on the role of quality in protecting the public's health
- The goal is to help ensure that policy and investment decisions are evidence-based, thereby promoting access to qualityassured medicines
- First area of focus: the link between poor quality medicines and the rise of antimicrobial resistance
- Quality Institute research fellows program in collaboration with Georgetown University Medical Center



#### Responding to the opioid crisis

- Largest cause of accidental death in the U.S.
- Prescription opioids often a gateway to other deadly drugs
- Increased use of overdose reversal medications
